We are honored you are visiting today. * Liturgy **Books** may be found on the **Candle Table** at the back of the church. * We **invite you to fill out a Visitor's Card**, also on the Candle Table & place it in one of the Collection Baskets there. * We do not take up a **Collection** during our services but rather ask you to place donations in one of the baskets on the Candle Table or next to the **Holy Water Font**. * While only Orthodox Christians who have prepared themselves may receive **Holy Communion**, everyone is welcome to come forward at the end of Liturgy to receive a blessing from our priest and to take the blessed bread. * It is the **Orthodox practice** to stand during services as a sign of reverence for the Lord but if you need to sit, please do so. Use of chairs is shared. If you are able, we particularly try to stand during the processions with the Gospel and the Gifts, during the Readings, the Creed, during the preparation of the Holy Eucharist, the Lord's Prayer and reception of Communion. * We **invite you** to stay after the Thanksgiving Prayers **for fellowship** and coffee, so that we may greet you personally, and to answer any questions you may have about our faith, our parish or today's service. * Please help yourself to the brochures and information on the east side counter. * All children **ages three through twelve** are encouraged to attend our Sunday School after Holy Communion. * **We hope you will visit us again very soon.** *

- LUMINARIAS FOR PASCHA NIGHT: Please talk to Diane Prokipchak if you are interested in helping put out luminarias or helping to light them Pascha night.
- PASCHA FOOD BASKET BLESSING: Tables will be set up on the east patio for your baskets. Baskets will be blessed after Pascha night services or after the Paschal Vespers on Sunday afternoon. There are flyers on the Literature Table on putting together a traditional basket.
- SLEEP ROOM FOR CHILDREN PASCHA NIGHT: As in the past, the Library will be available. Parents are responsible for taking turns minding the children. A chair will be reserved outside the room for the parent on guard. Please leave the door open at all times. If you have any questions please see Fr Nikolay.
- THE KITCHEN OVEN: will be set at 200°. PLEASE, DO NOT CHANGE IT!!! We need ALL meats, cheeses, breads and desserts, etc. to be brought to church cut up and on a plate, ready to be served. *Use disposable trays, bowls and pans where possible. Please bring meat that is being warmed, including spiral hams, roasts and whole chickens sliced and removed from the bone prior to coming to church. There will be a few outlets for crock pots. We need everyone to be responsible for helping clean up the tables, trays, and putting up the chairs & tables after the Pascha meal. PLEASE PUT YOUR CHAIRS AWAY WHEN YOU LEAVE.* We need you to take home any of your leftover food when you leave. DON'T FORGET TO RECYCLE! A food scrap pail will also be set out to feed farm animals.
- DINNER AT MIMI'S AFTER VESPERS ON PASCHA: The reservation is for 5:00pm. There is a sign up sheet on the Literature Table. When you sign up indicate the number of those planning to go to Mimi's in your group. A final count is needed as soon as possible. Thank you.
- ALL PARISH POTLUCK ON THOMAS SUNDAY to honor Fr. George for his Name Day (April 23), Mat. Ingrid on her Name Day (May 5th) and Fr. Nikolay on his birthday, May 9th! The Sisterhood will provide a cake. God grant you many years!
