If you are able, we particularly try to stand during the processions with the Gospel and the Gifts, during the Readings, the Creed, during the preparation of the Holy Eucharist, the Lord's Prayer and reception of Communion. * We invite you to stay after the Thanksgiving Prayers for fellowship and coffee, so that we may greet you personally, and to answer any questions you may have about our faith, our parish or today's service. * Please help yourself to the brochures and information on the Literature Table. * All children ages three through twelve are encouraged to attend our Sunday School after Holy Communion. * We hope you will visit us again.

PARISH FINANCIAL REPORT: YTD THROUGH JULY, 2010

FINANCIAL MID-YEAR REPORT.

Although expenses have slightly decreased from previous years, the July 31st year-to-date operating shortfall is -\$4884.70. This budget deficit is due to a decrease in expected tithe revenue. Since building fund donations have totaled \$6403.17 to date this year, we have the potential to balance the operating budget if slightly less donations are restricted to the building fund (and are instead general tithe contributions). Excess operating funds can always be transferred to the building fund, but not vice-versa. For questions or a copy of July's financial reports please talk to our treasurer, **John Teifel**.

SAFETY:

1. If your child is not a full head taller than the tables in the kitchen, please do not allow them in the kitchen unsupervised. There are too many hot ovens, pans, food (soups), and sharp items in the kitchen which could cause an injury.

BEFORE THE MEAL:

2. Please bring your food ready to serve or prepare it when you get to church. That is cutting it into serving sizes so all can enjoy, warming it up, etc. We will show where stuff is and how to use the ovens and our new microwave.
3. If you are not preparing food to be served, please do not come into the kitchen to check out what is being served. You are welcome to come in after the food is blessed.

SERVING THE FOOD:

4. Please let guests, and the frail and older parishioners get their food first.
5. Please consider each other and only take one spoon of any selection of food, so there is something left for the last person in line. You can always come back for seconds if there is any left.
6. Please consider taking home the uneaten food you have put on your plate to be eaten later.

AFTER THE MEAL:

7. We thank you for continuing to dispose of your trash and wiping down your trays; please don't forget the back of the tray.
8. We could use more help in the kitchen with wrapping up the food to be taken home, and washing, drying, and putting away dishes.
9. It would help if everyone scanned the church and the rooms for trash, especially uneaten food and put it in the trash.
10. Please put the toys & books your child has played with away.
11. Please fold up your chair and put it away.
12. Please get a wet rag from the kitchen and wipe down your table.
