THE PARISH ANNUAL MEETING AND ELECTION OF THE 2010 PARISH COUNCIL IS SCHEDULED FOR JANUARY 17th, 2010 DURING COFFEE HOUR

At the annual meeting we will hear reports about our various areas of ministry along with a summary of the 2009 finances. **The 2010 budget will also be presented for parish discussion and approval.**

Is there someone you'd like to see serve on the Council? Would you like to serve on our seven member Parish Council? *Don't be shy about turning in your own name in or in asking someone to serve. However, before turning in a nomination of someone, please check with them to make sure they are willing to stand for election. Nominations need to be turned into Father George in writing.*

According to the By-Laws of the Diocese of the South: Eligibility for election to the parish council: A voting member of the Parish who has been a member for one year is eligible for election to the Parish Council. In addition to the technical qualification of one year, the Parish Meeting must elect to the Parish Council, only those members of the Parish who are zealous for the Orthodox Faith, who are regular communicants at the Eucharist, who are active in the Parish, who are willing to work for the improvement, both spiritual and temporal of the Parish, who are not contentious and rebellious against the authority of the Church, and who are not motivated to seek office out of pride, but only out of a strong desire to work for the Lord and the building up of His Church. In our Diocese, officers of the Council are elected by the Council members at their first meeting.

Membership of the parish and attendance at the annual meeting: Members of the parish are those persons who have been baptized or chrismated in the Orthodox Church and consciously uphold and profess the Orthodox Faith, who are regular participants in the Holy Mysteries of confession and Communion, financially support the Parish and declare themselves to be members of the Parish. Anyone who has been a member of the Parish for a period of six months and is at least eighteen years of age may attend and vote at the parish meeting. All those who consider themselves part of the parish may attend the meeting.
