SUMMERTIME IS RAPIDLY DRAWING UPON US and it is not unusual to see a drop off in donations to the food banks at this time of year. Please remember the hungry so that the summer does not become a time of famine for all those living among us who find themselves in need in these troublesome days.

DURING THE PASCHAL SEASON, SINCE THE HOLY SPIRIT HAS NOT YET COME, we do not say the prayer *O Heavenly King*, but say instead *Christ is Risen from the dead*...three times. After the Leavetaking of Pascha, which comes this Wednesday, we no longer say *Christ is Risen*, but we still do not resume saying *O Heavenly King* until Pentecost when also, after the Divine Liturgy, we will kneel for the first time since Pascha during the *Kneeling Prayers* from the 'Vespers of Pentecost.' In the meantime, we keep the celebration to Pascha alive by continuing to sing *Christ is Risen* in the services and in our prayers and by greeting each other with: ***Christ is Risen! Indeed He is Risen!***

Use of chairs is shared. If you are able, we particularly try to stand during the processions with the Gospel and the Gifts, during the Readings, the Creed, during the preparation of the Holy Eucharist, the Lord's Prayer and reception of Communion. * **We invite you** to stay after the Thanksgiving Prayers **for fellowship** and coffee, so that we may greet you personally, and to answer any questions you may have about our faith, our parish or today's service. * Please help yourself to the brochures and information on the Literature Table. * All children **ages three through twelve** are encouraged to attend our Sunday School after Holy Communion. **We hope you will visit us again.***
