They were descended from the lineage of Aaron: St Zachariah, son of Barach, was a priest in the Jerusalem Temple, and St Elizabeth was the sister of St Anna, the mother of the Most Holy Theotokos. We had a beautiful Dormition feast day in a 15th century church just east of us one block. They started reconstruction about a month ago and the village women, led by Luba, meet every Tuesday to dig out the ruins. I was the first lay person to receive communion in the church since the parish priest was killed about 80 years ago. We had a meal immediately following in a building next to the church, also under renovation, shared with a stabled horse owned by the priest, Fr Sergei. The weather the past 2 weeks is rainy and cold (48-55°F), but it was the same last year and then September was great. Our love to everyone at All Saints.
