If you are able, we particularly try to stand during the processions with the Gospel and the Gifts, during the Readings, the Creed, during the preparation of the Holy Eucharist, the Lord's Prayer and reception of Communion. * We **invite you** to stay after the Thanksgiving Prayers **for fellowship** and the meal so that we may greet you personally, and to answer any questions you may have about our faith, our parish or today's service. * Please help yourself to the brochures and information on the east side counter. * All children **ages three through twelve** are encouraged to attend our Sunday School after Holy Communion.

ALSO COMMEMORATED THIS DAY

The son of Alphaeus one of the Twelve Apostles, was the brother of the holy Evangelist Matthew. He heard the Lord's words and witnessed His miracles. After the Descent of the Holy Spirit, the Apostle James Alphaeus and the Apostle Andrew the First-Called, made missionary journeys preaching in Judea, Edessa, Gaza, Eleutheropolis, proclaiming the Gospel, healing all sorts of sickness and disease, and converting many to the path of salvation. St James finished his apostolic work in the Egyptian city of Ostrachina, where he was crucified by the pagans.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

IT HAS BEEN AROUND 10 YEARS SINCE WE'VE HAD AN OFFICIAL ARCHPASTORAL VISIT TO OUR PARISH. We are all filled with joy and excitement about Bishop Alexander being in our midst on the last weekend of this month. Please allow me to share with you some points of Orthodox etiquette pertinent to His Grace being with us. When the Bishop is present please do not ask the priest for a blessing, but make a small reverence before His Grace (without crossing yourself), and then place your right hand over your left (palms up) and say "Master Bless", then kiss his right hand. Please do your best to arrive at Church and finish with venerating icons and lighting candles before the Bishop's arrival at 9:00 a.m. If you arrive late, it is best that you simply go to your place and venerate icons and light candles after the conclusion of the service. During the Archpastoral Liturgy there are times when the Bishop blesses with special long candles called "Dikiri & Trikiri". Please bow towards His Grace as he makes this blessing in your direction. After the small entrance there are several times when only the clergy are supposed to sing. Your cue for those hymns would be that the choir will not be singing, only the clergy. Thank you for your help in giving our Bishop a proper welcome to our wonderful Parish!
