COMMEMORATED THIS DAY

The Holy and All-praised Apostle Philip, was a native of the city of Bethsaida in Galilee. He had a profound depth of knowledge of the Holy Scripture, and rightly discerning the meaning of the Old Testament prophecies, he awaited the coming of the Messiah. After the Ascension of the Lord, the Apostle Philip preached the Word of God in Galilee, accompanying his preaching with miracles and undergoing sufferings. Then in Greece, Parthia, the city of Azotus, Syrian Hieropolis, Asia Minor, Lydia, Emessa. In the city of Phrygian Hieropolis he was killed praying for those who had crucified him and saving them from harm in an earthquake.

Saint Justinian was a great champion of Orthodoxy, a builder of churches and a Church writer. At his command, the Fifth Ecumenical Council was convened in the year 553, censuring the teachings of Origen and affirming the definitions of the Fourth Ecumenical Council at Chalcedon. He also attempted to secure religious unity within the Empire through his (unsuccessful) dialogues with the non-Chalcedonians.
