We are honored you are visiting today. * Liturgy **Books** may be found on the **Candle Table** at the back of the church. * We **invite you to fill out a Visitor's Card**, also on the Candle Table & place it in one of the Collection Baskets there. * We do not take up a **Collection** during our services but rather ask you to place donations in one of the baskets on the Candle Table or next to the **Book Store Table**. * While only Orthodox Christians who have prepared themselves may receive **Holy Communion**, everyone is welcome to come forward at the end of Liturgy to receive a blessing from our priest and to take the blessed bread. * It is the **Orthodox practice** to stand during services as a sign of reverence for the Lord but if you need to sit, please do so. Use of chairs is shared. If you are able, we particularly try to stand during the processions with the Gospel and the Gifts, during the Readings, the Creed, during the preparation of the Holy Eucharist, the Lord's Prayer and reception of Communion. * We **invite you** to stay after the Thanksgiving Prayers **for fellowship** and coffee, so that we may greet you personally, and to answer any questions you may have about our faith, our parish or today's service. * Please help yourself to the brochures and information on the east side counter. * All children **ages three through twelve** are encouraged to attend our Sunday School after Holy Communion.

- **PALM SUNDAY FISH FUNDRAISER TODAY:** a 5-6oz tilapia loin, green beans, rice pilaf, roll and pie. Suggested donation- \$8⁰⁰ adult plate, \$4⁰⁰ child's plate. Please stay to share a meal with us. If you cannot afford the suggested price, we are grateful to receive whatever you can give. We are also grateful to those who donate more. Proceeds support the charitable work of the Sisterhood. We over-bought fish so we will also have 2½ pound bags of frozen tilapia for sale at \$14⁹⁹.
- **VIGIL AT THE TOMB:** The sign up sheet to keep vigil at the tomb on Holy Friday and Holy Saturday is on the Literature Table.
- **RED EGGS FOR PASCHA:** We still have empty slots on the sign up sheet to make red-dyed hard boiled eggs for Fr Nikolay to give out at the end of the Pascha Divine Liturgy. You can begin bringing eggs to church on Holy Thursday to 11:15pm on Saturday night. Please use Greek dye that is on sale in the bookstore or onion skins.
- **AGAPE MEAL ON HOLY SATURDAY.** A few more things are needed. Please see the sign up sheet on the Literature Table.
- **SLEEP ROOM FOR CHILDREN PASCHA NIGHT:** The Library will be available as a children's sleep room as in past years. Please bring pillows and blankets/sleeping bags. Parents are responsible for taking turns minding the children. There must be 2 parents on duty at all times. There will be 2 chairs next to the door reserved for the "on duty" parents. Please leave the door open at all times.
- **PASCHA FOOD BASKET BLESSING:** Tables will be set up on the east patio for your baskets. Baskets will be blessed after Pascha night services or after the Paschal Vespers on Sunday afternoon. There are flyers on the Literature Table on putting together a traditional basket.
- **DONATIONS FOR PALM SUNDAY AND PASCHA FLOWERS ARE NEEDED.** There is a special basket next to the Tithe Box for your donations.
- **BOOKSTORE:** Service Books for Holy Week are for sale. Holy Week One Day at a Time and How to Put Together a Traditional Easter Basket are now on the Literature Table, upright in the holder to the left of the bookcases.
- **NEXT WEEK THE KITCHEN OVEN:** will be set at 200°. PLEASE, DO NOT CHANGE IT!!! We need ALL meats, cheeses, breads and desserts, etc. to be brought to church cut up and on a plate, ready to be served. Use disposable trays, bowls and pans where possible. Please bring meat that is being warmed, including spiral hams, roasts and whole chickens sliced and removed from the bone prior to coming to church. There will be a few outlets for crock pots. We need everyone to be responsible for helping clean up the tables, trays, and putting up the chairs & tables after the Pascha meal. PLEASE PUT YOUR CHAIRS AWAY WHEN YOU LEAVE. If the food that you bring, will be safe to save and serve Thomas Sunday, please package it and put it in the refrigerator. If this is not the case, or take home any of your leftover food.
