We are honored you are visiting today. * **Liturgy Books** may be found on the **Candle Table** at the back of the church. * **We invite you to fill out a Visitor's Card**, also on the Candle Table & place it in one of the Collection Baskets there. * We do not take up a **Collection** during our services but rather ask you to place donations in one of the baskets on the Candle Table or next to the **Holy Water Font**. * While only Orthodox Christians who have prepared themselves may receive **Holy Communion**, everyone is welcome to come forward at the end of Liturgy to receive a blessing from our priest and to take the blessed bread. * It is the **Orthodox practice** to stand during services as a sign of reverence for the Lord but if you need to sit, please do so. Use of chairs is shared. If you are able, we particularly try to stand during the processions with the Gospel and the Gifts, during the Readings, the Creed, during the preparation of the Holy Eucharist, the Lord's Prayer and reception of Communion. * **We invite you** to stay after the Thanksgiving Prayers **for fellowship** and coffee, so that we may greet you personally, and to answer any questions you may have about our faith, our parish or today's service. * Please help yourself to the brochures and information on the east side counter. * All children **ages three through twelve** are encouraged to attend our Sunday School after Holy Communion. * **We hope you will visit us again very soon.** *

- AGAPE MEAL FOR HOLY SATURDAY VESPERAL DIVINE LITURGY, April 13th. After the Vespertal Divine Liturgy we break our fast with bread, grapes, dates and figs. If you would like to volunteer to bring one of these items to the meal, there is a sign up sheet on the Literature Table.
- RED EGGS FOR PASCHA: sign up if you would like to make red dyed hard boiled eggs for Pascha. They are due at the church before 11:15pm Holy Saturday evening. Dye is available in the book store for the deep red color needed.
- LUMINARIAS FOR PASCHA NIGHT: Please talk to Lew Witz if you are interested in helping put out luminarias or helping to light them Pascha night.
- PASCHA FOOD BASKET BLESSING: Tables will be set up on the east patio for your baskets. Baskets will be blessed after Pascha services or later in the day at 3:00pm. There are flyers on the Literature Table on putting together a basket.
- SLEEP ROOM FOR CHILDREN PASCHA NIGHT: As in the past, the Library will be available. Parents are responsible for minding the children. Remember to bring pillows, blankets, etc. for them.
- FOR PASCHA: the kitchen oven will be set at 175°. PLEASE, DO NOT CHANGE IT!!! We need ALL POTLUCK FOOD including meats, cheeses, breads and desserts, to be brought to church cut up, ready to be served. Everyone will be responsible for cleaning up the tables, trays and kitchen and putting up the chairs & tables after the Pascha meal. Please take home any food left over from what you brought, as we will be having Fr George's Name Day celebration provided by the Sisterhood the following Sunday & your food will not keep.
- DINNER AT MIMI'S AFTER VESPERAS ON PASCHA: The reservation is for 5:00pm. There is a sign up sheet on the Literature Table. When you sign up indicate the number of those planning to go to Mimi's in your group. A final count is needed as soon as possible. Thank you.
