Hieromartyr Babylas the Bishop of Antioch

ALSO COMMEMORATED THIS DAY

The Hieromartyr Babylas and the three youths Urban, Prilidian, Epolonius and their mother Christodoula died as martyrs under the emperor Decius (249-251). The emperor arranged for a large festival in honor of the pagan gods. At the same time, Babylas was serving the Divine Liturgy in church. The idolater Decius, curious to witness the Divine Mysteries, decided to enter the church. St Babylas was unwilling to permit impiety in the temple of God. When the emperor approached the church doors, he refused to let him enter, so the emperor had to abandon his intention. The next day he commanded all the martyrs be tied to a tree and burned with fire. Seeing the stoic bravery of the saints, the emperor finally condemned them to be beheaded with the sword.

If you are able, we particularly try to stand during the processions with the Gospel and the Gifts, during the Readings, the Creed, during the preparation of the Holy Eucharist, the Lord's Prayer and reception of Communion. * **We invite you** to stay after the Thanksgiving Prayers **for fellowship** and coffee, so that we may greet you personally, and to answer any questions you may have about our faith, our parish or today's service. * Please help yourself to the brochures and information on the east side counter. * All children **ages three through twelve** are encouraged to attend our Sunday School after Holy Communion. * **We hope you will visit us again very soon.** *
