26 MARTYRS OF THE ZOGRAPHOU MONASTERY ON MT. ATHOS AT THE HANDS OF THE CRUSADERS

In the year 1274 at the Council of Lyons (in France), the Byzantine emperor Michael VIII Paleologos decided to buttress his waning power by forming a union with Catholic Rome. The monks of Mt. Athos adhered to the doctrines of the Fathers, and fearlessly censured those who accepted the Latin teachings. The emperor despised the monks for their opposition to his union, but since he did not want to provoke the Greeks, he decided to vent his spite upon the Athonite Slavs. By Michael's order, the servants of the Pope descended upon the Bulgarian Zographou monastery and the holy martyrs for their Orthodox Faith were burned in the monastery tower on October 10th, 1284.
