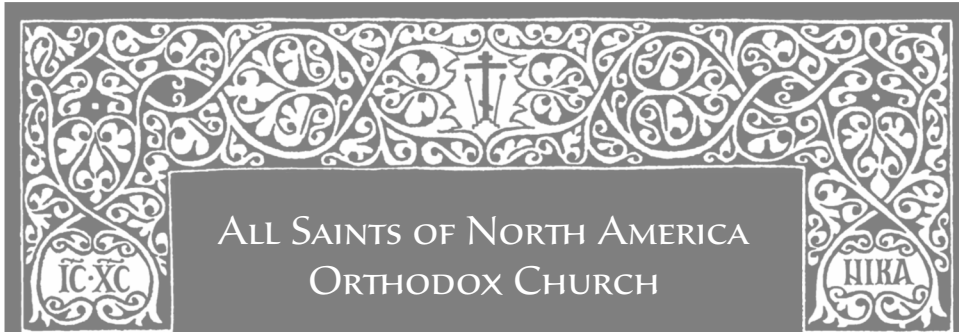

IF YOU WISH TO CONTRIBUTE to a charitable fund for **Matushka Ingrid** all you need do is write a check to ASONA and write "Matushka Ingrid" on the "for" line and it will be passed through to her. Thanks.

A friendly reminder about how to make an **ONLINE DONATION TO OUR OPERATING FUND:** The Diocese of the South has launched a portal at their website (www.dosoca.org) that can be used by parishioners to maintain their offerings on a regular basis. Simply go to the website and scroll down to the **PERSONAL DONATION PORTAL**. Select your parish (All Saints of North America is the first one on the list) from the drop down menu, enter the amount of your donation, complete the method of payment fields, then submit. Your offerings will be deposited in a dedicated diocesan account at Chase Bank from which they will be remitted to our parish in a matter of days. The diocese is assuming the cost associated with maintaining this portal including all transaction costs, so your offering will be remitted in total to our Church under your name so it can be properly accounted for on the parish books. This payment processing system contains the highest level of security obtainable for online transactions. If you have any questions regarding this please don't hesitate to call Fr Nikolay or Deacon Stephen.

Everyone should come to Church wearing a mask, except infants under the age of 2 (the requirements for our state are stricter than Archbishop Alexander's directives). Please enter through the west double doors, and then wash your hands in the restrooms before going to a designated spot in the Nave that will allow you to observe the required social distancing. When you come to Holy Communion, continue to maintain the social distancing from other communicants. We will not use the red cloths, rather each person is to take a tissue that will be provided and hold it under one's chin (parents please hold the tissue for your children). Please don't wipe your lips with the tissue, but simply hold the tissue as a precaution, preventing the Holy Mysteries from falling accidentally on the ground. If there is any of the Communion left on your lips, simply consume it. The tissues should be left in a white container provided for that purpose. Obviously, remove your mask right before coming for Communion and then promptly put it back on. In compliance to our Hierarch's directive, we'll not be offering zapifka (wine mixed with warm water in a glass container) and antidoron (blessed bread) right after Communion. Until further notice, please refrain from kissing Icons and other Holy objects, priest's hand, etc. Simply cross yourself and make a reverence before the Icons.
