## The Holy King Milutin

COMMEMORATED THIS DAY

Milutin was the son of Uroš I and Queen Helena and brother of Dragutin. He fought many battles defending his Faith and his people. He fought against Emperor Michael Palaeologus because Palaeologus accepted union with Rome and tried to force the Balkan peoples and the monks of Athos to recognize the pope. He fought against Shishman, King of Bulgaria, and Nogai, King of the Tartars, in order to defend his lands. All his wars were successful, for he constantly prayed to God and hoped in God. He built more than forty churches: beside those that he built in his own land--Treskavac, Gračanica, S<sup>t</sup> George in Nagorič, the Church of the Holy Theotokos in Skoplje, Banjska and so forth--he also built churches outside of his land, in Thessalonica, Sofia, Constantinople, Jerusalem and the Holy Mountain. He entered into rest in the Lord on October 29, 1320 A.D. His body was soon shown to be incorrupt and miracle-working; and as such, it reposes even today in the Church of the Holy King in Sofia, Bulgaria. ## Ω ANNOUNCEMENTS Ω

**IT HAS BEEN AROUND 10 YEARS SINCE WE'VE HAD AN OFFICIAL ARCHPASTORAL VISIT TO OUR PARISH.** We are all filled with joy and excitement about Bishop Alexander being in our midst Today! Please allow me to share with you some points of Orthodox etiquette pertinent to His Grace being with us. When the Bishop is present please do not ask the priest for a blessing, but make a small reverence before His Grace (without crossing yourself), and then place your right hand over your left (palms up) and say "Master Bless", then kiss his right hand. Please do your best to arrive at Church and finish with venerating icons and lighting candles before the Bishop's arrival at 9:00 a.m. If you arrive late, it is best that you simply go to your place and venerate icons and light candles after the conclusion of the service. During the Archpastoral Liturgy there are times when the Bishop blesses with special long candles called "Dikiri & Trikiri". Please bow towards His Grace as he makes this blessing in your direction. After the small entrance there are several times when only the clergy are supposed to sing. Your cue for those hymns would be that the choir will not be singing, only the clergy. Thank you for your help in giving our Bishop a proper welcome to our wonderful Parish!

**ACQUIRING THE MIND OF CHRIST:** *Embracing the Vision of the Orthodox Church:* On October 18<sup>th</sup> we began a new book study on this work of Archimandrite Sergius. "St Paul clearly states: 'Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus...!' (Phil 2:5) How do we acquire this Mind of Christ and where is it to be found? For the Orthodox Christian, salvation is the acquisition of this Mind of Christ which is to be found in the Church. This acquisition moves us from the image of God to the likeness of God; through our obedience to this call we begin to know God and this knowledge is eternal life (John 17:3). This small book hopes to begin to answer how acquiring the Mind of Christ is possible and why it is necessary in our lives today. Fr Archimandrite Sergius serves as the 16<sup>th</sup> Abbot of St Tikhon's Monastery. He teaches at St Tikhon's Seminary and has traveled extensively for the Monastery and Seminary giving talks and retreats."
