As you can see from our September Calendar, All Saints now has two schedules: A Summer Schedule and a Fall-Winter-Spring Schedule.

The Summer Schedule (End of May to End of August) will be simply what we have been doing so far: Vespers on Wednesday evening followed by the Orthodoxy class and the typical weekend liturgical schedule.

The Fall-Winter-Spring Schedule (September to the Middle of May) will have a few more components: A daily Divine Liturgy on Thursday morning will be added at 9:30am. On Friday morning we'll add the Jesus Prayer from 10:00am to 10:20am. At 10:30am we will have a Continuing Education class designed to enrich and deepen our Orthodox faith. Due to the busier schedule during Fall-Winter-Spring, Fr Nikolay will be taking Monday as a day off, and will not be checking his e-mail that day. The additional liturgical and educational components during Fall-Winter-Spring will be suspended or modified during Lent and on the occasion that we have another daily Liturgy or other services and events that week (as is the case for the first two weeks of September). Use of chairs is shared. If you are able, we particularly try to stand during the processions with the Gospel and the Gifts, during the Readings, the Creed, during the preparation of the Holy Eucharist, the Lord's Prayer and reception of Communion. * We **invite you** to stay after the Thanksgiving Prayers **for fellowship** and coffee, so that we may greet you personally, and to answer any questions you may have about our faith, our parish or today's service. * Please help yourself to the brochures and information on the east side counter. * All children **ages three through twelve** are encouraged to attend our Sunday School after Holy Communion. *
