

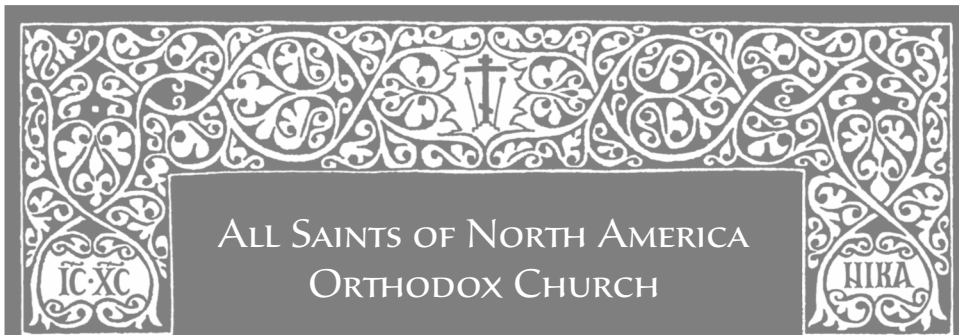

ANNOUNCEMENTS

SISTERHOOD ANNUAL PALM SUNDAY (APRIL 28TH) FISH DINNER FUNDRAISER: We will have baked fish, rice pilaf, green beans, salad, rolls, dessert and beverages. Gluten free dessert will be available. Suggested donation is \$10 for an adult plate, \$5 for a child plate. Extra pieces of Fish \$3. Everyone is encouraged to stay regardless of ability to donate for the meal as we would be honored to have you as a guest of St. Anna.

HELP NEEDED TO TIE WILLOWS AND PALMS FOR PALM SUNDAY at 5:00pm on Friday, April 26. Many hands make light work!

FLOWER DONATIONS: We appreciate your Special Donations to purchase the Palm Sunday palms and willows and flowers to decorate the tomb on Holy Friday & Pascha. Please write "flowers" on the memo line of your check and place in the Tithe box.

RED EGGS FOR PASCHA! There is a sign up sheet to donate the red-dyed hard boiled eggs which are traditionally given out by Fr. Nikolay at the end of the Paschal Liturgy. Use of brown eggs is encouraged to get a better color. Greek Red Dye can be purchased from the bookstore or dyed with yellow onion skins. Commercial PAAS type dye does not give the blood red color needed. Please sign up for each dozen you commit to bring. Please have your eggs at church no later than by the end of the Vespers Liturgy on Holy Saturday. We are storing the eggs in the refrigerator next to the stove.

SIGN UP TO READ AT THE TOMB: After the Vespers of Holy Friday, we keep vigil at the tomb by continuously reading the Psalms, only stopping for the Friday evening Matins. We continue the vigil through the night, stopping at 9:05am on Saturday when Hours begin before Saturday's Vespers Divine Liturgy. After we set up for Pascha, the reading of The Acts of the Apostles will be continuously read at the tomb until 11:30pm when we start the Paschal services. A sign up sheet will be on the Literature Table in church. Reading is done in a plain (monotone) non-dramatic way. If you have questions, please see Fr. Nikolay.

SIGN UP TO BRING ITEMS FOR THE HOLY SATURDAY AGAPE MEAL. We break our fast after the Holy Saturday Vespers Divine Liturgy with a small, traditional agape meal. We need grapes, figs, dates, bread and wine. The table is set up with all the food ready to be served before the service starts at 9:30am, so please slice/plate/portion your food at home or come early enough to do it BEFORE THE SERVICE BEGINS. Please cut grapes into small bunches. Thank you!
