The Holy Martyrs Roman and Barulas

COMMEMORATED THIS DAY

St. Roman was a deacon of the church in Caesarea and zealously preached the Gospel in Antioch. He was subjected to tortures, flogged and scraped without mercy. During this, St. Roman saw a child by the name of Barulas, and said to the Eparch of Antioch, Asclypiades: Even this small child has more understanding than you, old man, for he knows the true God and you do not. The eparch questioned Barulas about his faith, and he confessed Christ the Lord as the One True God, contrary to false idolatry. Asclypiades commanded that young Barulas be beheaded and St. Roman be strangled in prison. Thus, both of these martyrs inherited the Kingdom of Christ in the year 303.
